History

- The predecessor of the College was the Political and Social Studies College, which was founded as a state institution in 1945 in Prague. After two transformations in 1949 and 1953, political science was finally excluded from study programmes. Political science programmes were restored only after the Velvet revolution in 1989 when Political science Departments were created at various Universities. The College was accredited by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport in 2003. The College started regular instruction in the academic year 2003/2004.

Basic information about Academic Programmes

The study of Political and Social Sciences provides students with a wellbalanced knowledge of political, philosophical and other social disciplines related to the policy making process. During the first year students obtain basic knowledge of political science, economics, law and modern history, during the next two years they extend their knowledge in the sphere of political theory and political practice. The College prepares experts for jobs in political parties, NGOs, governmental institutions and mass media. After finishing Bachelor programmes students can study Master programmes at any Czech University. The College is private institution. Czech students have to pay a tuition fee of CZK 42 000 (full-time students and combined studies) per academic year, payable in one or two instalments.

The number of students was 487 during academic year 2007/2008.

Admission

The applicants are required to have completed their secondary education. All applicants have to pass an interview.

The College offers to students a library, access to PC, accommodation and a cafe (refectory).

The College provides all above-mentioned bachelor study programmes for international students in the Czech language only. International students have to pay a fee of USD 2500 per academic year.
