■ **Basic Information about the Academic Programme**

The bachelor study programme is interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary. In addition to studies of economics and management, courses in law and technical civil engineering are presented. Specialists in real estate need knowledge in these fields. The studies are based on examining theoretical knowledge and extending it into practical applications.

■ **Lifelong Learning**

The College offers the following lifelong learning programmes: appraisal, estimation

and other specific courses related to estimation. There is no entrance examination.

Admission

Applicants are required to have completed their secondary education. Other conditions are also set. Decisions on acceptance or rejection of applicants will be made by the chancellor.

Applicants are required to submit a properly filled written application to the college before the closing date for applications.

1st application submission deadline: 1st June 2009

2nd application submission deadline: 1st September 2009

If there is free capacity, the College can also accept the application forms after the 2nd deadline.

Tuition Fees

For the 2009/2010 academic year, the fees will be CZK 25 000,- per semester.
