- History** ■ On 27th October 2003, the Ministry of Education granted a state consent to Rašín College Ltd. to operate as a college with accreditation for a bachelor study programme in Economics and Insolvency, and courses in Crisis Management. The first academic year was started in September 2004. Since its establishment, the school has been placing an emphasis on creative and specialist activities. It organises conferences, some on an international level, training sessions, colloquia and seminars. Rašín College is focused on the creation of a system of profession-oriented legal and economic education. It is focused on issues connected with the solution of crisis phenomena in business economics, on issues of preventing crisis phenomena and company revitalisation. The aim of the study programmes is to prepare and educate creative people who will be able to solve problems responsibly in practice and to defend these ways of solution in a qualified way.

The school prepares specialists able to solve both standard and non-standard management tasks, mainly tasks focused on the solution of problems of companies in a crisis or in bankruptcy.

Rašín College, as the only one in the Czech Republic, is focused on education in the field of crisis insolvency management. Its graduates will find employment as trustees in bankruptcy, liquidators, members of crisis manager teams, in leading positions in production, commercial and also administrative spheres where very good knowledge of both economics and law is required.

Accreditation of the Master Degree studies in the master study programme in Economics and Insolvency, and courses in Revitalisation of Economic Subjects and Resource Management was approved in May 2008.

Organisation of Studies

- Each academic year is divided into two semesters (winter and summer semesters), each lasting 12 to 14 teaching weeks. Each semester is followed by a five-week period of examinations.

The standard time for the full-time bachelor study programme is 3 years. The studies in the bachelor programme are completed with a final state exam, a part of which is a presentation of the bachelor dissertation. The graduates are conferred a Bachelor Degree (i.e. "Bachelor"), abbreviated as "Bc."

The standard time for the full-time master study programme is 2 years. The graduates are awarded the Master Degree of Engineer (in abbr. "Ing").

Full-time studies are organised on the basis of individual study plans.

The College is a private institution, and students have to pay a tuition fee of CZK 46,000 (bachelor study program), and CZK 54,000 (master study program) per academic year, payable in one or two instalments.

Applicants are required to have completed their secondary education. All applicants have to pass an interview about their motivation.

The College offers the following services: Library, IT classroom (internet), classroom

for foreign language study. Accommodation and public catering can be provided directly in the school building, which is situated in the immediate vicinity of the university premises in Brno.

The College runs many non-degree courses in a life-long education system.
