College of Applied Economic Studies, Ltd. was established in January 2007. The State Accreditation Commission approved the first bachelor study program in 2007. Regular teaching began in the 2007/2008 academic year. The college cooperates closely with state offices, insurance companies, hospitals and many other institutions with links in the health and social area, and with many other institutions.

- Structure of the Institution** ■ The college is not divided into faculties. It has 7 departments: Department of General Economics, Department of Applied Economics, Department of Mathematics, Statistics and Informatics, Department of Technical and Environmental Sciences, Department of Law, Arts and Language Studies, Department of Health and Social Sciences, and Department of Lifelong Studies. There are many specialists working in these departments.

There is a detached branch in České Budějovice, where classes are also held.

### Basic information about the academic programs

The College prepares students for careers in management and for positions as economic specialists in health and social work, and also in waste management. The study programs offer a high-standard curriculum to develop the students' knowledge and skills and enable them to progress in their careers in the Czech Republic, in European Union, and beyond the EU.

Applied Economics in the Health and Social Area – this study program was established to provide an education in the field of economics, health studies, social policy, etc. The main aim is to prepare well-educated graduates to work in lower and middle management in health institutions and social institutions (e.g. hospitals, retirement homes, insurance offices, sanatoria, etc.)

Applied Economics in Waste Management – the main aim is to prepare well-educated graduates who can progress in their careers in waste management, environmental policy, environmental engineering, etc. (e.g., in industrial companies, public administration, power plants, mining companies etc.), especially in lower and middle management positions.

The College is a private higher education institution, and students have to pay a fee of 40 000 CZK per one academic year, payable before the beginning of the academic year.
