- History** ■ In 2001 the school received official sanction of the the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic to operate as a private college. It is accredited to teach bachelor courses.

B 6804 – Law specialty – Business Law

B 6804 – Law specialty – Social Law Activities and Employment Rates.

In accordance with the law, the bachelor courses are specialized and oriented towards practical applications. The students familiarize themselves with the relevant branches of law and the necessary general subjects in such a manner as to make the sum of the acquired knowledge refl ect the profile of the graduate's professional training. Some consideration is also given to comparing the Czech legal system with those in the Western Europe states and the USA, and the relationships between the Czech Republic and these states from the point of view of international law.

- Structure of the Institution** ■ The University of Advanced Legal Studies is not divided into faculties.

- Organisation of Studies** ■ The academic year is divided into two semesters (winter and summer semesters), each of them lasting 14 teaching weeks. Each semester is followed by a four to five week period of examinations. At the conclusion of studies (at the end of the 6th semester), the student presents and defends his bachelor thesis and undergoes the bachelor examination, which includes three profile subjects

(within the fields of Business Law, Company Law, Business Relations and Disputes and Labor Law, or Social Law Activities and Employment Rates, Social Policy Theory, Labor Law, and Employment Policies).
